Our local pledge and priorities

We are committed to working with you and our partners to identify local concerns which help us to determine the priorities for your neighbourhood.

Eastleigh Town Centre

We are working with licensees and Eastleigh Borough Council to deal with drunken and abusive behaviour quickly. We are continuing to support the Pub Watch scheme run by the licensees.

Boyatt Wood, Allbrook and Newtown

Operation Nemesis is aimed at preventing burglaries and car thefts. We will also be combating speeding in your local area by carrying out speed enforcements regularly for example on Twyford Road.

Aviary Estate and Fleming Park

PCSO's will carry on patrolling these areas to reduce anti-social behaviour and anti social use of vehicles.

You said: Parking concerns, Pirelli Estate.

We did: Increased our patrols in the new development, ensured Eastleigh Borough Council enforcement teams were aware of residents concerns. This has reduced complaints to almost zero in the past two months.

You said: Anti-social Behaviour from a property & residents in Newtown.

We did: Ensured twice daily patrols, worked with Environmental Health who installed noise monitoring equipment. Close liaison with private landlord to commence court proceedings. Family have now moved out to alternative accommodation.

You said: Anti-social Behaviour on Lawn Road Recreation Ground

We did: Regular & recorded targeted patrols in this area both days and evenings. We have had very few reports of anti-social behaviour over the past few months.

You said: Speeding on Twyford Road

We did: Conducted speed enforcement operations & also targeted vehicles contravening the weight restriction.

You said: Purses stolen from elderly women in the town centre.

We did: Increased uniform officers on busy market days and also conducted covert operations, fully utilised CCTV and other departments. Worked with Shop Watch to raise awareness and secured funding for purse lanyards. A number of suspects arrested and charged with thefts.

You said: Cyclists without lights & riding on pavements.

We did: Visited schools, colleges & youth groups to raise road safety awareness. We run regular 'Operation Dismount' checks & enforce legislation with penalty notices where appropriate.

Winter Crime Prevention Advice from your Safer Neighbourhoods Team

Shut all windows and lock them at night and when you leave your property unattended.

Lock all rear and front doors at night and when you are out. If you have a UPVC door with a multi-point lock ensure you lift the handle and lock it with a key.

If you are going out in the evening leave a light on so your home looks occupied. If you go out when it is daylight and won't be getting home until dark then timer switches are available to set the time for when you want your lights to come on.

When you are out shopping don't leave bought items and other valuables such as phones, sat nav's and bags visible in your car.

Keep your wrapped Christmas presents hidden and put them out on the night.

Break all wrapping and boxes down and place in your bin ensuring it is not visible and take large boxes to the recycling centre – don't give criminals the heads up on what nice new valuables you have in your home.

If you are going away, try to make your home look occupied by using time switches.

Cancel milk and newspaper deliveries. Get a trusted friend or neighbour to collect your post and draw your curtains to make your home look lived in while you are away.

Tell us if your house is unoccupied.
