## ACTION UNDERTAKEN IN RELATION TO YOUR PRIORITIES

**You said:** Anti-social behaviour, including people urinating in the street, is a problem around Latimer Walk, the Memorial Park and Waitrose car park.

**We did:** After our street surgery back in February, we have now written and delivered feedback forms to all relevant addresses around the Memorial Park. We are continuing to liaise with the management at shops on Latimer Walk and the ground keepers at the Memorial Park. Targeted patrols are also ongoing.
