Here are some details about what you have told us concerns you in your local area, and what action we have taken:

You said: There are issues in Brookley Road car park in Brockenhurst with anti-social youths who are disrupting surrounding residents.

We did: PCSO Andy Brown was joined by Parish Councillors in Brookley Road car park Brockenhurst to meet local residents and listen to their concerns about anti-social behaviour and other issues in the area. We've been working with local councils, housing and Safer Streets teams to combat the problem with high visibility patrols, and regular contact with residents has resulted in a significant reduction in calls about ASB in the car park. Our long-term aim is to work with Brockenhurst Parish Council and other local agencies to find a suitable place where the young people of Brockenhurst can go that is more appropriate than the car park. If you have any ideas we would be pleased to hear from you.

You said: Motorists have been driving at excessive speed on All Saints Road.

We did: Speeding is one of the factors that most affects the quality of life in our communities. The Speedwatch scheme allows members of the community to become volunteers and take action on roads of concern in their area. The scheme will be managed by the local Safer Neighbourhood Teams but run by volunteers.

Volunteers use equipment that monitors the speed of passing traffic and they record the details of offending vehicles. Vehicle checks will be done overnight by the Police National Computer Bureau

and letters will be sent out the next day to the registered keepers. Repeat offenders can expect a visit from a local officer to discuss their anti-social driving habits and the risks for them and other road users.
