## ACTION UNDERTAKEN IN RELATION TO YOUR PRIORITIES

**You said:** You want us to reduce anti-social behaviour in Latimer Walk, the Memorial Park and Waitrose car park.

**We did:** Towards the end of last month we had seen an increase in reported ASB incidents in and around Romsey town centre and in response to this we have set up dedicated daily patrols of the affected areas. This has resulted in fewer incidents. However, there have been reports of similar issues at Malmesbury Road Green. We are currently working on a long-term initiative to address this problem and I would like to take this opportunity to encourage you all to report any incidents which occur in this location.

## CRIME PREVENTION
