JUSTICE SEEN, JUSTICE DONE

After numerous calls from residents about a youth riding a mini motorbike on footpaths around Withy Close, and with no helmet on, we have identified him and given him a Section 59 warning. This means that if he is identified riding in this manner again the mini motorbike will be seized.

POLICE APPEAL

We are still appealing for witnesses after a number of vehicles parked in Cavendish Close had their wheels damaged.

CRIME PREVENTION



We have been working closely with our colleagues at Trading Standards and will be setting up a 'No Cold Calling Zone' in Seward Rise.

We will also be working closely with the committee of the Woodley Village Hall due to an increase in the number of reports of anti-social behaviour and youths congregating there. We will be working hard to target this area and reduce the problems there.

ACTION UNDERTAKEN IN RELATION TO YOUR PRIORITIES

You said: You were concerned about anti-social behaviour from local youths in the Brook Way area, particularly on the neighbouring field which is a proposed development site.

We did: Enquiries have been made and a letter has been sent to the land owner to discuss the issue. Regular meetings will be set up with the residents of Brook Way to keep them updated on the situation.
