## Our local pledge and priorities

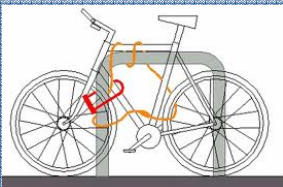
We are committed to working with you and our partners to identify local concerns which help us to determine the priorities for your neighbourhood.

1. To address rowdy and inconsiderate behaviour through robust use of fixed penalty notices. Confiscation of alcohol on the street is also important to us as police in Totton.
2. Through high visibility PCSO and police officer patrols on pedal cycles, to challenge and deal firmly with anti-social behaviour on the street
3. To engage are young people either in schools or on the street. Also to work with our partner agencies (Social Services, Housing agencies etc).

### Cycle Thefts

As mentioned we are having an increase in the Totton area of thefts of cycles.

Please would local residents make sure sheds and cycles are kept secure at all times we as police at Totton are conducting enquiries to find out who is responsible for this increase, persons involved will be dealt with robustly by police.



### Criminal damage

Criminal damage decrease from the last report but we still have had 16 incidents. These range from objects being thrown or fired at properties or vehicles. Vehicle damage is still a priority for us but this offence seems to have improved. ## Rowdy and inconsiderate behaviour

There have been 14 reports made involving anti-social behaviour and rowdy and inconsiderate behaviour. Most of these reports have been made relating to youths drinking alcohol in the street and shouting, and swearing.

If you see or hear this sort of behaviour going on then please use the 101 number and report it to us as soon as possible.

If seen, the youths will have the alcohol confiscated and will be dealt with by being escorted home to their parents. If they are being anti-social whilst in drink and commit damage they will be dealt with more robustly.

If you are a parent or guardian then please ensure that you are aware of what your children are getting up to during the day and evenings and please speak to them about the impact of their behaviour on others within the community, particularly the elderly.

## Burglaries

There have been six reported incidents of burglary. Five have been in non-dwellings while the other was in a dwelling. We have had an increase in unknown people gaining access into sheds taking cycles and tools. We had an incident where a vehicle was taken from a local farm as the vehicle was not secure. Police had some success with this as the

vehicle was later found in the Totton area and returned to its owner.

## Keep up the good work

We would like to thank all residents who have been calling us and reporting any suspicious vehicles and individuals who they have witnessed in the area.

This information really helps us with our investigations and is often very valuable so please continue to report.
