1023. Minutes of Last Meeting

1024. Ch Supt Chatterton

1024.1 Ch Supt Chatterton has received a global email from David Leverett regarding Fire Wardens. Cherie Watson will speak to James Collins regarding have we got enough and that they are trained.

1025. A/CI White's Update

1025.1 A/CI White gave an update on PES and said that the peer assessments are underway and will be completed in the next month.

1025.2 An update was given on Safety Net and that it is green in every category. Ch Supt Chatterton gave thanks to everyone involved in this. Safety Net is still not populating the website as intended. Work is ongoing but no date is set for this to occur.

1025.3 On the 16th March ACPO will be deciding who the new District Commander will be, A/CI White has spoken to Julie Jones regarding the information flow.

1025.4 An update on performance within East Hampshire was given.

1025.5 The rural crime review is now with the Chief Constable and he will take this to Hampshire Police Authority. Country Watch will be launched on the 6th May.

1026. CI Jackson's Update

1026.1 CI Jackson said that the merger with Hart and Rushmoor is going well and gave an update on this. This was discussed further. CI Jackson will speak to Cherie Watson regarding office space.

Action: A/CI Clancy is to look at what other custody centres are doing and do some more work on this by Ch Supt Chatterton. Obtain some more data and through the District Commanders arrange for 1-2-1s and update him in 2-3 months time. This is to be a programme of ongoing performance management.

- 1027.9 A/CI Clancy said that a search has been set up for shadow inspectors to do a daily search on lates and a weekly search for violent crime. This was discussed and it was decided that A/CI Clancy is to hold off sending this request until the weekend DMM and CIC cover is resolved.

At the moment the TPT inspectors have taken on some of this work. It was decided that this would be discussed further on Tuesday 15th March at the meeting at Bramshill.
