What we have done to address community concerns:

You said: You wanted us to tackle and reduce drug-related incidents in Romsey town centre.

We did: Patrols will be carried out in local areas that have come to our attention where possible drug dealing is occurring, and we will take robust action against anyone found to be involved in this illegal activity

Justice seen, justice done

A number of cannabis warnings have been issued to offenders within the town centre in the last month. One person was arrested and reprimanded for the possession of a controlled substance, and a warrant was carried out, resulting in two people being issued with fixed penalty tickets.

Six people have been arrested and charged with assault, and one person arrested for assault was given a youth restorative disposal. We have arrested

someone for criminal damage, arrested and charged a person for a public order offence, and given a fixed penalty notice for a public order offence. Three people have been arrested for impairment and one reported for summons after a driving complaint. One person has been charged and two reported for summons after thefts from from Scats, Aldi and Greatbridge Services.

Crime prevention

There have been reports of anti-social behaviour outside The Abbey. We are patrolling the area regularly and have made a number of alcohol seizures. Thank you to all who are reporting these incidents, please continue to report any further problems in the area. We have also seen a slight increase of theft of bicycles recently, please remember to lock and secure your bike with a D-lock when visiting the town centre or at home.
