## CRIME PREVENTION

### Arson

There have been three arsons in the village over the past month.

It is a fact that most fires that are started deliberately are started outside the building, with vandals setting light to anything readily to hand. Items like waste packaging and rubbish in open skips are obvious examples, as are disused outbuildings. Please keep this in mind and ensure no waste is left discarded around the village and keep all outbuildings locked and secure.

### Burglary

During the summer months we may want to just open up our windows and enjoy the sunshine but please follow these simple crime prevention tips to deter burglars and avoid becoming the victim of crime:



- Always close and secure your windows and doors at night when you're sleeping or when you're away from your home, even if you're only in the garden
- If you are going away, ask a neighbour or friend to open and close curtains and pick up post so it doesn't build up by the letter box
- Consider using a timer switch for your lights
- Ensure that you cancel any milk or newspapers before your holiday
