## **BURGLARY**

## **Community priorities for West Totton:**

1. To address rowdy and inconsiderate behaviour through robust use of fixed penalty notices, legislation for the dispersal of intimidating groups and confiscation of alcohol on the street.
2. Conducting high visibility PCSO and police officer patrols on pedal cycles to challenge and deal firmly with anti-social behaviour on the street, particularly swearing, spitting, littering and dog fouling.
3. To promote responsible citizenship among our young people by engaging with them on the street as well as in schools, clubs and groups on a regular basis.
4. To work in partnership with other agencies (housing associations, the local authority, social services, etc) to ensure that issues affecting the quality of life, particularly in residential areas, are dealt with by seeking long term solutions, and not quick fixes.
