ACTION WE HAVE TAKEN IN RELATION TO YOUR PRIORITIES

You said: Youths are hanging around in the Asda and South Street car parks, causing noise and litter. Many of you find their presence intimidating.

We did: We increased patrols in the area and made all Andover officers aware of the complaints. This issue seems to have died down due to increased police presence and also the weather conditions.

You said: Some individuals are parking dangerously and inconsiderately when they are dropping children off to Anton Junior

School. Some residents' driveways are being blocked.

We did: We have arranged our duties so that all members of the Safer Neighbourhoods team are out and about in the mornings, enabling us to spend more time at the schools and to engage with more people while they are on the move. PCSO Hollie Wilson has been liaising with the school to monitor problems with parking and has been speaking with motorists around Barlows Lane about road safety.

CRIME PREVENTION

Please remain vigilant when you are out and about doing your Christmas shopping. Be aware of what and who is around you and do not leave any of your property unattended.

Unfortunately, purse thefts have increased slightly in the town centre so please keep purses inside your handbag and keep your handbags zipped up and on your person at all times. Look out for the town beat officers who can provide you with free lanyards to secure your purse, or pop into the police station to collect one.
