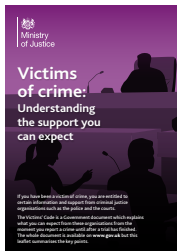

VICTIM PERSONAL STATEMENT

One of your specified rights is for a Victim Personal Statement (VPS) to be taken. A VPS gives you the opportunity to explain, in your own words, the impact that the crime has had on you and your family. It will be taken into account by all criminal justice agencies involved in the case and it can play a key part in sentencing.

RESTORATIVE JUSTICE

Restorative Justice is a victim-focused approach that empowers victims and communities by giving them the opportunity to communicate with the person responsible for the offence, in order to explain exactly how it has impacted them.

The Blue Lamp Trust Bobby Scheme provides practical help to elderly and vulnerable people who have been, or who are at risk of becoming, victims of crime or anti-social behaviour in or near their home. The scheme offers activities such as repairs following a burglary, the fitting of security chains / window locks / spy holes, the installation of smoke alarms and the provision of fire prevention advice.
