Please note, the information above excludes attempted rape as this was not requested. As such, someone can be arrested for an offence of rape but the crime itself could be classified as attempt rape. In this instance, the figures may show an individual arrested for rape but this would be missed in the crime data and vice versa.

In addition, an individual can be arrested for multiple offences and therefore arrest data cannot always be comparative to crime data due to multiple victims / offences therefore the above information relate to crimes whereby an arrest has been recorded.

Hampshire Constabulary believe the increased number of male rapes is linked to an increase confidence in reporting. In this time we have developed a specialist trained team who support and gather evidence from victims and also ensure that referrals are made to specialist partner services such as ISVA (independent sexual violence advocates).
