

## Stop and Search.

Quarter 4: January 2021 to April 2021.

**Assistant Chief Constable Maggie Blythe:** "Stop and search is an important part of our community policing, helping us protect all we serve."

Our Independent Advisory Groups meet quarterly to review a sample of stops, including body-worn video.

#### Disproportionality.

Likelihood of being stopped and searched compared to a white person.

**Black:** 6.9 times more likely.

**Other:** 4.1 times more likely.

**Mixed race:** 2.5 times more likely.

**Asian:** 1.2 times more likely.

#### **Reason for Stop.**

Drugs – cannabis: 1931.

Drugs – other: 556.

Stolen goods: 314.

Others include Game/poaching, Firearms, Article – criminal damage, Offensive weapon, Bladed article, Going equipped, seizure alcohol/tobacco, and Public Order.

#### **Outcome of Stop:**

No Further Action: 2396.

Community Resolution: 519.

Arrest: 272.

Others include voluntary attendance, penalty notice for disorder, tobacco seized, alcohol seized, caution – simple/conditional, and postal requisition/postal charge/summons.

**Stops by ethnicity:**

White: 2512.

Not Stated: 390.

Others include Asian, Black, Mixed, and Other.
