Purpose of Job	To investigate priority volume crime as a case officer and to assist in the investigation of serious and complex crime under the supervision guidance and mentoring of a PIP 2 investigator.		
Key Accountabilities	1. Investigate all types of predatory sexual offending against children, including physical contact and the taking, making and distribution of images of abuse. 2. Demonstrate a competent understanding and ensure effective delivery of child protection responsibilities and procedures relating to the investigation of crimes against children and young persons. 3. Work in partnership with internal and external agencies to pursue offenders through the lifetime of their criminality and safeguard victims and potential victims. This will include representing the Constabulary at relevant multi-agency conferences. 4. To give regular and effective service (mandatory). Note: This role profile is designed to assist post holders with understanding what is expected of them in their role. Hampshire and Isle of Wight Constabulary may ask them to undertake other duties, as required, which are not necessarily specified on the role profile but which are commensurate with the grade of the post. The role profile itself may be amended from time to time within the scope and general level of responsibility attached to the post.

Role Profile

Hours of duty are as set out in the POLIT duty pattern. These are ordinarily (8-4) but there is frequent requirement to work earlier and occasionally later than this subject to meeting operational needs. Occasional periods away from home may be necessary.

In order to maintain public confidence, post holders are expected to project a professional image. Constabulary dress standards will be observed, smart business attire will be worn unless operational requirements dictates otherwise.

The standard of dress for a PSI is smart business attire and wearing a lanyard.

Hold a current authorisation to drive police vehicles.

Post-holders may be deployed to work anywhere within the Hampshire Police area and on occasions there may be a need to work beyond the county boundaries.

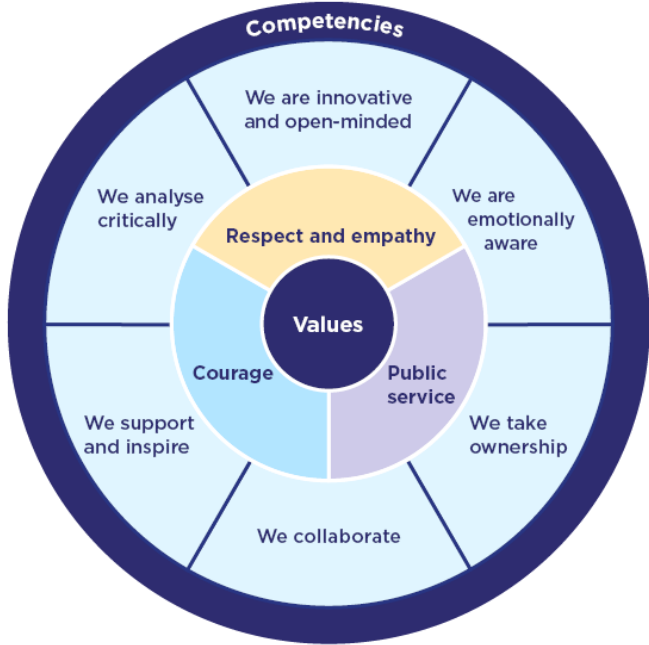
